

Seats - 98/100 seats declared






Gubernatorial Race Results



- 36 Gubernatorial elections.
- Democrats flipped at least seven of the 26 GOP-held seats.
- 2018 results increased the total number of Democratic governors to at least 23.
- Heading into the election, 33 of the 50 governorships were held by Republicans and 16 by Democrats. Alaska's current governor is an independent.

Attorneys General Race Results



- **30 Attorneys General elections out of the 43 states in which the office is elected.**
- **Democrats flipped at least three GOP-held seats in the election.**
- **Wisconsin Democrat Josh Kaul has claimed victory, but there has been no official call. If Kaul is declared winner, Democrats will have flipped four GOP-held seats.**
- **Heading into the election, 27 attorney general offices were held by Republicans and 21 were held by Democrats.**



Results Count Per Legislature




- 979 consumer data privacy bills were introduced at the state level during the most recent legislative session
- Bills were introduced in 49 out of 50 states

State Consumer Privacy Efforts

Enactment of Consumer Data Privacy Legislation

(Most Recent Legislative Session)



- 279 consumer data privacy bills were enacted at the state level during the last legislative session
- Of note, California, Colorado, and Vermont adopted robust consumer data legislation
